The scholarship application is open to all seniors at W. W. Samuell High School who will graduate in May, 2026. A \$1,500 scholarship will be awarded in May, 2026. The funds may be used for tuition, books, a computer, room & board in on-campus housing, or other required fees at a university, community college, trade school or other accredited educational institution. The scholarship will be paid directly to the school in which you are enrolled. Applications will be reviewed by a committee of Samuell alumni and a decision will be made based on financial need, GPA, participation in extracurricular activities, community service, and an essay. - (3) One-Page essay on topic outlined below
- (4) Two letters of recommendation signed by teachers or members of the community who are not family members

After the scholarship is announced, the Foundation may request that the recipient attend an informal meeting with the donors and write a thank you note.
